PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68756 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jean Kessel of 6100 NE Mineral Spring Road, Carlton, Oregon, 97111, phone 852-7468, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Hawn Creek, and reservoir to be constructed under Application R-68755, Permit * for the PURPOSE of maintenance of reservoir for recreation,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 12, 1986

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 850 feet North and 180 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 35, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35, Township 3 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 3 South, Range 4 West, WM Section 35 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Recreation

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 28, 1987 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
