PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68738 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Donald W. Godard of 13770 SW Rawhide Court, Beaverton, Oregon, 97005, phone: Day-#229-5171; Night-#644-7659, for the use of the waters of Willamette River, a tributary of Columbia River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 51.6 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 2, 1986

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.65 Cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1800 feet North and 3000 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 19, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 19, Township 12 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Benton.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 12 South, Range 4 West, WM Section 19 SW1/4 SE1/4 37.0 acres SE1/4 SE1/4 3.6 acres NW1/4 SE1/4 11.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 17, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
