This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68725 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Lewis A. Johnson, Jr. of 16908 Coho Drive, Brookings, Oregon, 97415, phone (307) 789-7204, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a

tributary of Chetco River,
for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 12, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 120 feet South and 1270 feet West from the East quarter corner of Section 34, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 34, Township 40 South, Range 13 West, WM, in the County of Curry.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 40 South, Range 13 West, WM Section 34 NE1/4 SE1/4 Domestic Use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 29, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
