PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68787 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Prairie Wood Products, PO Box 386, Prairie City, Oregon, 97869, phone 820-3351, for the use of the waters of John Day River,

for the PURPOSE of Industrial use to include log deck sprinkling and operation of co-generation power plant (water treatment, gland water, recharge water and recharge water for boiler and cooling tower),
that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 14, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.5 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1400 feet South and 176 feet East from Northwest corner of NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 11, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 11, Township 13 South, Range 33 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 29, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
