PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68754 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Harry A. Walters and Mabel Walters of 18430 Kings Grade Road NE, Newberg, Oregon, 97132, phone 538-2585, for the use of the waters of Spring #1 when available with any deficiency in the available supply of water from Spring #1 to be* for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 11, 1986 for use from Spring #1
August 5, 1986 for use from Spring #2

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Spring #1- 2530 feet North and 1380 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 34; Spring #2- 2490 feet North and 1366 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 34, both being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 34, Township 2 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* made up by appropriation from Spring #2,, a tributaries of the Chehalem Creek,

Township 2 South, Range 3 West, WM Section 34 NE1/4 SE1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 25, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
