PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68808 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Ray I. and Barbara J. McCullough of Route 1, Box 24-D, Council Creek Road, Riddle, Oregon, 97469, phone 874-2898, for the use of the waters of Council Creek, a tributary of Cow Creek, for the PURPOSE of Irrigation of 2.35 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 4, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.034 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2530 feet North and 650 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 33, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 33, Township 30 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 30 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 33 NW1/4 SW1/4 2.36 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/70 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided that the right allowed herein shall be further limited during the period July 15 through September 30 of each year to the irrigation of a non-commercial garden not to exceed one-half acre in area and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 22, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1989.
