

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, R. R. Schultz (Name of Applicant) of Medford (Postoffice), County of Jackson State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Star Gulch, Tributary of Big Applegate (Name of stream) tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 6.0 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Placer Mining (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located S12° E of 1/4 Cor. Between Sec. 20 and 29 (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the NW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 29, Tp. 39 S (No. N. or S.)

R. 3 W, W. M., in the county of Jackson (No. E. or W.)

5. The ditch to be 3/4 miles in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 28, Tp. 39 S (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

R. 3 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (No. E. or W.)

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Burton Ditch

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, sub-  
ject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to  
one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject  
to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Star Gulch  
for placer mining purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial  
use and not to exceed 6.0 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of  
rotation. The priority date of this permit is March 11, 1921

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 5, 1922 and shall  
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1923

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 4, 1924
