PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68822 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Raymond D. and Christine C. Dodge of 7281 Williams Highway, Grants Pass, Oregon, 97527, phone 862-2391, for the use of the waters of Applegate Lake Reservoir, constructed under Permit R-7810, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation of 16.6 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 11, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 16.0 acre-feet stored water only.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1570 feet North and 80 feet West from the East quarter corner of Section 19, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 19, Township 37 South, Range 5 West, WM. Applegate Lake Dam is located in the S 1/2 SE 1/4 Section 25, Township 40 South, Range 4 West, WM. Both in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 37 South, Range 5 West, WM	Section 19	SE1/4	NE1/4	8.0 acres
	Section 20	SW1/4	NW1/4	8.6 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 4.5 acre-feet and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 6-07-10-W0621 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 22, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89.
