## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68828 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Raymond W. Cayford and Judith A. Cayford of PO Box 62, 4919 Highway 227, Trail, Oregon, 97541, phone 878-3244, for the use of the waters of two springs, tributaries of Trail Creek, being 0.002 cubic foot per second from Spring \* for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for one family,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 16, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Spring #1- 400 feet North and 1160 feet West from the center quarter corner of Section 17; Spring #2- 460 feet North and 1120 feet West from the center quarter corner of Section 17, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 17, Township 33 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

\* #1 and 0.003 cfs from Spring #2,

Township 33 South, Range 1 West, WM Section 17 SW1/4 NE1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 22, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1989.
