PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68586 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Galice Sub. Water Co., 12143 Galice Route, Merlin, Oregon, 97532, phone 479-8577, for the use of the waters of South Fork Rocky Gulch and an unnamed stream, a tributaries of Rogue River, being 0.01 cubic foot per second from* for the PURPOSE of Domestic supplies for 23 families, being 0.01 cubic foot per second primary supply from South Fork Rocky Gulch for two families and 0.03 cfs secondary supply from the unnamed stream for 23 families; provided further that the right ** that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 13, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: South Fork Rocky Gulch: 800 feet South and 90 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 35; Unnamed Stream: 800 feet South and 2250 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 35, being within the South Fork Rocky Gulch: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 35; Unnamed Stream: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 35, both in Township 34 South, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * South Fork and 0.03 cfs from the unnamed stream, provided the total quantity diverted shall not exceed 0.03 cfs,
- ** allowed herein for the secondary supply from the unnamed stream is limited to periods when flows in South Fork Rocky Gulch are turbid.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 30, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988.
