## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68859 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to E. O. Breier and Ina L. Breier of Route 1, Box 325, Drain, Oregon, 97435, phone 836-2657, for the use of the waters of four springs, tributaries of Pass Creek, being 0.003 cubic foot per second from Spring #1, 0.003 \* for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for two families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 10, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Spring #1- 420 feet North and 580 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 35; Spring #2- 290 feet North and 660 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 35; Spring #3- 150 feet North and 670 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 35; Spring #4- 70 feet South and 930 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 35, being within the Springs #1, #2 and #3 \*\*
A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

cfs from Spring #2, 0.002 cfs from Spring #3 and 0.002 cfs from Spring #4,

SE 1/4 SE 1/4; Spring #4- NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 35, all in Township 21 South. Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

Township 21 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 35 NE1/4 NE1/4 Domestic use for two families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 30, 1988 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89.
