PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68865 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Carl I. Vistica of 14271 Wilco Highway NE, Woodburn, Oregon, 97071, phone (Home) 981-6702, (Work) 378-2309, for the use of the waters of Pudding River, a tributary of Willamette River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 23.5 acres and supplemental irrigation of 39.4 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 18, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.79 CUDIC foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 3560 feet North and 1810 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 21, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 21, Township 5 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Marion.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, provided further that although declared herein to be for supplemental irrigation in part the right allowed may, in the interest of conserving the ground water supplies, be exercised at times when water is available in the ground water supply provided that the total quantity diverted from all sources of supply does not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 30, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988, Extended to October 1, 1990

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89-Extended to October 1, 1996
