PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68961 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to George H. and Clara E. Schroeder of Route 4, Box 253, Sherwood, Oregon, 97140, phone 625-6069, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of King Creek, for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 17, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1450 feet North and 950 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 13, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 13, Township 6 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 6 South, Range 4 West, WM	Section 13 NW1/4 SW1/4	Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden
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Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 30, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
