PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68698 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Clyde Holliday and Sons, Route 2, Box 90, John Day, Oregon, 97845, phone 575-0665, for the use of the waters of Pine Creek, a tributary of John Day River, for the PURPOSE of Irrigation of 493.3 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 7, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 12.3 cubic feet per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: (Staley Ditch) 3050 feet and 1800 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 36; (Hillis Ditch) 1050 feet South and 1240 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 36; (Horsley Ditch) 400 feet South and 950 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 36; (McKenna Ditch) 1600 feet North and 730 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 36; (#5 Ditch) 4500 feet *

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* North and 60 feet West from the Northwest corner of Section 36; (Staley Ditch) being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 36; (Hillis Ditch) being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 36; (Horsley Ditch) being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 36; (McKenna Ditch) being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 25; (#5 Ditch) being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 26 all in Township 13 South, Range 32 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 26, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89
