## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68739 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to his permit is issued to Ralph L. and Peggy J. Mory of 1240 A Chetco Avenue, Brookings, Oregon, 97415, phone 469–6013, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a

tributary of Winchuck River, for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 30, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 625 feet North and 600 feet West from the East quarter corner of Section 8, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 8, Township 41 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Curry.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 41 South, Range 12 West, WM Section 8 SE1/4 NE1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 26, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
