PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68746 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Charles Warren Farmer, Jr. and James Gerald Farmer, 209 South 7th Street, Nyssa, Oregon, 97913, phone 372-5194 or 372-3837, for the use of the waters of an unnamed waste ditch and Lockett Gulch, tributaries of Snake River, for the PURPOSE of Supplemental irrigation, being 1500 gallons per minute from unnamed waste ditch for supplemental irrigation of 280.4 acres and 146 gpm from Lockett Gulch for supplemental irrigation of 13.0 acres, that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 4, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1646 gallons per minute.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Waste ditch- 300 feet South and 250 feet East from the Northwest corner of SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 11; Lockett Gulch- 600 feet South of the Northwest corner of the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 12, being within: Waste ditch- SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 11; Lockett Gulch- SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 12, Township 20 South, Range 46 East, WM, in the County of Malheur.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 26, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89.
