PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68758 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to H. Wayne Kee, Route 3, Box 915, Prineville, Oregon, 97754, for the use of the waters of Crooked River, a tributary of Deschutes River and Prineville Reservoir constructed under Permit R-2223, for the PURPOSE of Irrigation of 5.0 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 13, 1986 for 0.063 cubic foot per second and August 19, 1986 for 0.062 cubic foot per second.

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.125 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1920 feet North and 340 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 8, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 8, Township 15 South, Range 16 East, WM, in the County of Crook.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 14 South, Range 15 East, WM Section 36 SE1/4 SE1/4 5.0 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is subject to the terms and conditions of contract 14-06-100-1499 between the Bureau of Reclamation and Peoples Irrigation Company or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 26, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89.
