PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68942** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Oregon Pine, PO Box 66, Riddle, Oregon, 97469, phone 874-2231, for the use of the waters of John Day River, a tributary of Columbia River,

for the PURPOSE of Industrial (Log deck sprinkling),

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 10, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1050 feet North and 2662 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 22, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 22, Township 13 South, Range 31 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 26, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1989.
