PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68804 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jon Drake and Linda Drake of 17755 Shady Lane, Monmouth, Oregon 97361, phone (Work) 838-0251, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Luckiamute River, for the PURPOSE of Domestic for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 24, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1050 feet West from the Southeast corner of the Alpheus F. Cherry D.L.C., being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 14, Township 9 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 9 South, Range 6 West, WM	Section 14 NW1/4 NW1/4	Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden
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Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 17, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
