PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68813 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Wilson Bros. Farms, PO Box 246, Mosier, Oregon, 97040, phone 478-3318, for the use of the waters of Columbia River, a tributary of Pacific Ocean,

for the PURPOSE of Irrigation of 105.5 acres.

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 6, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.32 cubic feet per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 4120 feet North and 2610 feet East from the Northwest corner of Lot 4, Section 6, being within the Lot 3 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4) Section 31, Township 3 North, Range 12 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 North, Range 12 East, WM 24.8 acres Section 6 NW1/4 NE1/4 SW1/4 NE1/4 6.6 acres NW1/4 SW1/4 38.2 acres SE1/4 NW1/4 7.4 acres Township 3 North, Range 12 East, WM Section 31 NE1/4 SW1/4 0.1 acre SW1/4 SW1/4 2.5 acres NW1/4 SE1/4 13.4 acres SW1/4 SE1/4 11.3 acres SE1/4 SE1/4 1.2 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 17, 1988 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89.
