## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68833 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to James Brockman and Marjorie Ward of 4619 Dole Road, Myrtle Creek, Oregon, 97457, phone 863-5368, for the use of the waters of South Umpqua River, a tributary of Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of Livestock,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 21, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1420 feet North and 350 feet West from the South quarter corner of Section 7, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 7, Township 29 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 7 NE1/4 SW1/4 Stockwater  
NW1/4 SE1/4

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 17, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89.
