## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68848 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Loveness Farms, by Loyal H. Loveness, HC 62, Box 20-A, Malin, Oregon, 97632, phone 723-6611 or 723-3831, for the use of the waters of Mill Creek, a tributary of Tule Lake, and Simms Reservoir constructed under Application R-3113,\* for the PURPOSE of Irrigation of 15.8 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 8, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.395 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: North 77 degrees 4 minutes East 1708.9 feet from the Northwest corner of Section 18, Township 41 South, Range 13 East; Simms Reservoir- North 41 degrees West 3050 feet from the Southeast corner of Section 31, Township 40 South, Range 13 East, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 7, Township 41 South, Range 13 East; Simms Reservoir- NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 31, \*\*

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- \* Permit R-252,
- \*\* Township 40 South, Range 13 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

Township 41 South, Range 13 East, WM Section 18 Lot 2 (SW1/4 NW1/4) 1.4 acres  
NE1/4 SW1/4 6.8 acres  
Lot 3 (NW1/4 SW1/4) 7.6 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 17, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
