## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68929 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Geoffrey R. and Melodie K Oriet of Route 1, Box 255-C, Gaston, Oregon, 97119, phone 985-7491, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Scoggins Creek, for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for one family,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 30, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 294.12 feet North and 130.65 feet West from the Northeast corner of NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 30, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 19, Township 1 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 1 South, Range 4 West, WM Section 30 NW1/4 NE1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 17, 1988 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
