## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68965 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Georgia E. Henderson of 1410 Kubli Road, Grants Pass, Oregon, 97527, phone 846-7164, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of unnamed stream, for the PURPOSE of Stock water,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 20, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1200 feet North and 1100 feet East from the center quarter corner of Section 31, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 31, Township 37 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 37 South, Range 4 West, WM Section 31 NW1/4 SE1/4 STOCK WATER

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 17, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
