PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60859 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Max E. Morrow of Route 2, Box 484, McMinnville, Oregon, 97128, phone 472-6578, for the use of the waters of McCall Spring, a tributary of Baker Creek,
for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for one family (at old house site),

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 7, 1980,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 90 feet North and 296 feet West from the Northeast corner of Isaac LeMaster DLC, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 1, Township 4 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 4 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 2 SE1/4 SE1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 31, 1988 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
