PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68842 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Clyde Fenimore of HC 60, Box 3280, Lakeview, Oregon, 97630, phone 947-3928, for the use of the waters of Drews Creek, a tributary of Goose Lake, for the PURPOSE of Irrigation of 59.9 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 29, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.5 cubic feet per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 300 feet South and 550 feet East from the North quarter corner of Section 19, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 19, Township 40 South, Range 19 East, WM, in the County of Lake.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to $\frac{1}{40}$ of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is subject to terms and conditions of the stipulation between Lakeview Water Users, Incorporated and Clyde Fenimore recorded at page 1662, Volume 6, Miscellaneous Records of the Water Resources Director and by reference made a part of this permit, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 31, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1989.
