## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68855 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Edward R. and Viviane P. Tallman of PO Box 63, Arch Cape, Oregon, 97102, phone 436-2814, for the use of the waters of an unnamed creek, a tributary of Pacific Ocean, for the PURPOSE of School use and Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden, being 6.0 gallons per minute for school use and 4.5 gpm for domestic use, that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 10, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 10.0 gallons per minute.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 283 feet North and 249 feet East from the Southwest corner of the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 6, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 6, Township 3 North, Range 10 West, WM, in the County of Tillamook.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 3 North, Range 10 West, WM	Section 6	NW1/4 NW1/4	SCHOOL USE
Township 3 North, Range 10 West, WM	Section 6	NW1/4 NW1/4	Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 31, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89.
