PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68969 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Douglas County Water Resources Survey, Room J-103, Justice Building, Roseburg, Oregon, 97470, phone 440-4255, for the use of the waters of Cow Creek, a tributary of South Umpqua River, and 204.0 acre-feet of stored water from * for the PURPOSE of Industrial, being 1.2 cubic feet per second from Cow Creek supplemented by 199.0 acre-feet of stored water from the reservoir for use at the D. R. Johnson Lumber Company site and 5.0 acre-feet stored water only at the ** that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 1, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.2 Cubic feet per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Louisiana-Pacific Corporation: 170 feet North and 1120 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 35; D. R. Johnson Lumber Company: 650 feet North and 1750 feet West from the East quarter corner of Section 24, being within the Louisiana-Pacific Corporation: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35, Township 28 South, Range 6 West; D. R. Johnson Lumber Company: SW 1/4*** A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * Galesville Reservoir constructed under Application R-61641, Permit R-9964,
- ** Louisiana-Pacific Corporation site,
- *** NE 1/4 Section 24, Township 30 South, Range 6 West, WM, both in the County of Douglas.
