PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68774 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Warrenton-Hammond School District #30 of 820 SW Cedar Street, Warrenton, Oregon, 97146, phone 861-2281, for the use of the waters of Skipanon River, a tributary of Columbia River, for the PURPOSE of Aquaculture,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 1, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 455 feet South and 1240 feet West from the quarter corner between Section 27 and Section 28, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 28, Township 8 North, Range 10 West, WM, in the County of Clatsop.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 8 North, Range 10 West, WM Section 28 NE1/4 SE1/4 AQUACULTURE
NW1/4 SE1/4

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 23, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90 .
