PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68930 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

Gordon and Isa M. Bosworth of PO Box 26, Tidewater, Oregon, This permit is issued to 97390. phone 528-3661; and Ina Louise Paulson and Keith E. Paulson of PO Box 117, Tidewater, Oregon, 97390, phone 528-7401 for the use of the waters of an unnamed * for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for two families and irrigation of 1.83 acres, being 4.5 gallons per minute for domestic use and 6.5 gpm for irrigation,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 30, 1986 for 5.6 gallons per minute and December 4, 1986 for 5.4 gallons per minute.

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 11.0 gallons per minute.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 4202 feet North and 740 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 34, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 34, Township 13 South. Range 10 West, WM, in the County of Lincoln.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 13 South, Range 10 West, WM Section 34 NW1/4 NW1/4

Domestic use and irrigation of 0.73

acre

Township 13 South, Range 10 West, WM Section 34 SE1/4 NW1/4

Domestic use and irrigation of 1.10 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 23, 1988 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90 .
