PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 6893] and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Mary M. Jacks of 7200 Highway 238, Jacksonville, Oregon, 97530, phone 899-1346, for the use of the waters of Deadman Creek, a tributary of South Umpqua River,

Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for two famlies and irrigation of 4.5 acres, being 0.01 cubic foot per second for domestic use and 0.05 cfs for irrigation,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 1, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 750 feet South and 920 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 18, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 18, Township 30 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 30 South, Range 1 West, WM Section 18 NW1/4 NW1/4

Domestic use for two families and irrigation of 4.5 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right allowed herein shall be further limited during the period July 15 through September 30 of each year to use of water only for human consumption and irrigation of a noncommercial garden not to exceed one-half acre in area.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 23, 1988 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90 .
