PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68932 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to William J. Butler of Beulah Route, Juntura, Oregon, 97911, phone 277-3241, for the use of the waters of Bender Creek, a tributary of Warmsprings Creek, and Murphy Reservoir constructed under Permit R-1005, for the PURPOSE of Irrigation of 51.2 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 1, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.28 cubic feet per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 10 feet South and 550 feet East from the North quarter corner of Section 36, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 36, Township 18 South, Range 37 East, WM, in the County of Malheur.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 19 South, Range 37 East, WM Section 2 NW1/4 NE1/4 18.2 acres SW1/4 NE1/4 24.8 acres SE1/4 NW1/4 6.9 acres NE1/4 SW1/4 0.9 acre NW1/4 SE1/4 0.4 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-1005, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 23, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19, 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 $\,$ 90 $\,$.
