PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68998 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Austin A. Dickinson of 96961 North Bank Rogue, Gold Beach, Oregon, 97444, phone 247-2976, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Rogue River, for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 21, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1175 feet North and 913 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 2, being within the Government Lot 7 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4) Section 2, Township 36 South, Range 14 West, WM, in the County of Curry.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 36 South, Range 14 West, WM Section 2 NE1/4 SE1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 23, 1988 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90 . Extended to October 1, 1991
