PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69000 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Monrovia Nursery Company, 12600 SE Alderman Road, Dayton, Oregon, 97114, phone 868-7941, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and Stockhoff Reservoir constructed under Permit R-4838, for the PURPOSE of Nursery use (irrigation of containerized nursery stock),

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 21, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.34 cubic feet per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 140 feet North and 1550 feet West from the Northwest corner of Kimsey DLC #43, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 6, Township 5 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
