## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68945 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to George G. Rooney and Vivian M. Rooney of 151 Whistler Park Road, Roseburg, Oregon, 97470, phone 673-5810, for the use of the waters of a spring stream,  
for the PURPOSE of Domestic for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden -- provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any \* that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 16, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 270 feet South and 630 feet East from the West quarter corner of Section 21, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 21, Township 26 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

\* prior right existing for the same use and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

Township 26 South, Range 4 West, WM Section 21 NE1/4 SW1/4	Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden
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Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 27, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
