## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68970 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Ramon J. Seidler and Katherine L. Seidler of 2450 SW 53rd Street, Corvallis, Oregon, 97333, phone 752-3514, for the use of the waters of Mary's River, a tributary of Willamette River, for the PURPOSE of Irrigation of 42.5 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 3, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.53 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 100 feet South and 2325 feet East from the Southeast corner of Prior Scott DLC No. 44, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 10, Township 12 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Benton.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 27, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90 .
