PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68983 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Barbara R. Morgan of Route 2, Box 641, Prairie City, Oregon, 97869, phone 820, 3615, for the use of the waters of Reynolds Creek, a tributary of John Day River, for the PURPOSE of Irrigation of 50.0 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 29, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.25 cubic feet per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: POD #1 (Axe Ditch)- 100 feet South and 300 feet West from the North quarter corner of Section 30; POD #2 (Round Meadow Ditch)- 2100 feet South and 700 feet East from the North quarter corner of Section 25; POD #3 (South Reynolds Ditch)- 2450 feet South and 200 feet West from the North quarter corner of Section 25; POD #4 (Reynolds Ditch)- 2450 feet South and 1100 feet West from the *

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* North quarter corner of Section 25, being within the (POD #1) NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 30, Township 13 South, Range 35 East; (POD #2) SW 1/4 NE 1/4, (POD #3) SE 1/4 NW 1/4, (POD #4) SE 1/4 NW 1/4 all of Section 25, Township 13 South, Range 34 East, WM, in the County of Grant.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 27, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
