PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68972 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Pedee Memorial Evangelical Church of North America, 12680 Kings Valley Highway, Monmouth, Oregon, 97361, phone 838-2129, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Luckimute River, for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 5, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 945 feet South and 300 feet East from the Northeast corner of NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 34, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 34, Township 9 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 9 South, Range 6 West, WM	Section 34 NW1/4 NW1/4	Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden
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Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
