PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68997 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Director, Department of Veterans Affairs, 700 Summer Street NE, Salem, Oregon, 97310, phone 373-2388, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream,
for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for one family,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 20, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1835 feet North and 1015 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 9, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 9, Township 26 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 26 South, Range 12 West, WM Section 9 NW1/4 SW1/4 Domestic use for one family

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90 .
