PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69048 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

Mary L. Little of HC 52, Box 289, Coos Bay, Oregon, 97420, phone This permit is issued to 267-7547, for the use of the waters of two unnamed streams, being use of water from unnamed Stream #1 when available with any deficiency in the available supply from * for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 3, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: POD #1- 360 feet South and 730 feet West from the center quarter of Section 28; POD #2- 635 feet South and 450 feet West from the center quarter of Section 28, both being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 28, Township 25 South, Range 11 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Stream #1 to be made up by appropriation of water from Stream #2, tributaries South Fork Coos River,

Township 25 South, Range 11 West, WM Section 28 SE1/4 SW1/4

Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1988 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
