PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69056 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to International Paper Company, 1940 Madison Road, Oakland, Oregon, phone 459-5905, for the use of the waters of Umpqua River, a tributary of Pacific Ocean, for the PURPOSE of Temperature control for frost protection and cooling,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 15, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 4.9 cubic feet per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 60 feet North and 410 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 30, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 30, Township 23 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The permittee shall record and submit annually to the Water Resources Department all pertinent data pertaining to use of water for temperature control on forms furnished.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90.
