PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69057 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Valerie A. Burnett of 90594 Deadwood Creek Road, Deadwood, Oregon, 97430, phone 964-3172, for the use of the waters of a stream, a tributary of Siuslaw River, for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for three families,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 15, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1225 feet South and 275 feet West from the Southeast corner of NW 1/4 of Section 29, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 29, Township 17 South, Range 9 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 17 South, Range 9 West, WM Section 29 SW1/4 SE1/4 Domestic use for three families

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90 .
