PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69086 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to J. Doug Dunn of Route 1, Box 810, Prineville, Oregon, 97754, phone 447-1850, for the use of the waters of McKay Creek, a tributary of Crooked River, for the PURPOSE of Irrigation of 23.3 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 7, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.58 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: POD #1- 1830 feet North and 2520 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 22; POD #2- 550 feet North and 1950 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 22, being within the (POD #1) NE 1/4 SW 1/4; (POD #2) SE 1/4 SW 1/4 both of Section 22, Township 13 South, Range 16 East, WM, in the County of Crook.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90 .
