## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68740 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Kirk Arnot Day of Route 1, Box 1389, Bandon, Oregon 97411, phone 347–4277, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Pacific Ocean,

for the PURPOSE of Irrigation, temperature control, and flood harvesting of cranberries on 2.0 acres, being 0.05 cubic foot per second for irrigation, 0.3 cubic foot per second for temperature control and 0.1 cubic foot per second for flood harvesting, that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 12, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.3 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 706 feet North and 340 feet East from Southwest corner of SE quarter, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 35, Township 29 South, Range 15 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South, Range 15 West, WM Section 35 NW1/4 SE1/4 0.5 acre SW1/4 SE1/4 1.5 acres

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second of its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 24, 1988 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90 .
