## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68789 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Charlotte Albertson of P.O. Box 141, Coquille, Oregon 97423, phone 396-2648, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and a spring,

for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for one family and irrigation of 1.0 acre, being 0.005 cubic foot per second from the unnamed stream for domestic use and 0.0125 cubic foot per second from the spring for irrigation, that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 16, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.0175 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: POD #1 (unnamed stream) 1550 feet South and 370 feet West; POD #2 (spring) 880 feet South and 590 feet West, both from Northeast corner, being within the (#1) SE 1/4 NE 1/4; (#2) NE 1/4 NE 1/4, of Section 18, Township 28 South, Range 13 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 28 South, Range 13 West, WM Section 18 NE1/4 NE1/4 UNNAMED STREAM  
domestic use

Township 28 South, Range 13 West, WM Section 18 NE1/4 NE1/4 SPRING  
irrigation 1.0 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 24, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90 .
