PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68844 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Roland R. Hanselmann of Smith River Road, Box 28, Drain, Oregon 97435, for the use of the waters of an unnamed spring,

for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for one family,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 26, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1200 feet South and 1075 feet East from Southeast corner NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 33, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 33, Township 20 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 20 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 33 NW1/4 SW1/4 DOMESTIC

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 24, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90 .
