PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68933 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to John E. La Vallee, Jr., (through Santiam Water Control District) of 9493 W. Stayton Road S.E., Aumsville, Oregon 97325, phone 749-1508, for the use of the waters of North Santiam River, a tributary of Santiam River, for the PURPOSE of Aquaculture,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from October 1, 1986,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.7 Cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1800 feet South and 2830 feet East from the West quarter corner of Section 11, being within Lot 2 (SW 1/4 SE 1/4), Section 11, Township 9 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Marion.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 9 South, Range 2 West, WM Section 1 NE1/4/SW1/4 AQUACULTURE NW1/4/SE1/4 AQUACULTURE

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 24, 1988 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1989 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90 .
