## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69037 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Barbara A. Lyons of 204 Coos City-Sumner Road, Coos Bay, Oregon 97420, phone 269-5658, for the use of the waters of two streams

for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for two families and irrigation of 2.55 acres, being 0.01 cubic foot per second from Stream #3 for domestic use and 0.03 cubic foot per second from Stream #4 for irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 23, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: POD #1 - 1035 feet South and 450 feet East from West quarter of Section 24, being within NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 24; POD #2 - 0 feet North and 1200 feet West from Southeast corner of Section 23, being within SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 23, both being within Township 26 South, Range 13 West, WM, in the\*

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 24, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 89 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90 .
