PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69089 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to William Byron Roberts of 1546 Clarks Branch Road, Myrtle Creek, Oregon 97457, phone 863-6705, for the use of the waters of a spring,

for the PURPOSE of Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one—half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; use of water is limited during the period July 15 through September 30 of each year to human consumption and* that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 8, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 680 feet North and 575 feet West from South quarter corner of Section 31, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 31, Township 28 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* irrigation of non-commercial garden not to exceed 1/2 acre in area,

Township 28 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 31 SE1/4 SW1/4

Domestic use including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and non-commercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 24, 1988, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19, 89.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 90 .
