PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 69106 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Rick Rolie of 202 Oak Street, Silverton, Oregon 97381, phone 873-2090, for the use of the waters of Davis Creek and Abiqua Creek,

for the PURPOSE of Supplemental irrigation and irrigation, being 0.15 cubic foot per second from Davis Creek for supplemental irrigation of 12.0 acres, 0.16 cfs from Davis Creek when available with any deficiency in the available supply at Davis* that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 22, 1987,

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.52 cubic foot per second.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: #1 (Davis Creek) - 1700 feet South and 100 feet East; #2 (Abiqua Creek) - 1400 feet South and 800 feet East; #3 - 1200 feet South and 1550 feet East, all from the Northwest corner, Section 29, #1 and #2 being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, #3 - NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 29, Township 6 South, Range 1 East, WM, in the County of Marion.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* Creek to be made up by appropriation from Abiqua Creek for irrigation of 13.0 acres and 0.21 cfs from Abiqua Creek when available with any deficiency in the available supply at Abiqua Creek to be made up by appropriation from Davis Creek for irrigation of 17.0 acres,

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The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 24, 1988 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1989 . Extended to October 1, 1990 Extended to October 1, 1991
Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1990 . Extended to October 1, 1991
